Financially, the replacement energy-efficient chiller for Elkhorn Lodge and property-wide installation of new thermostats in Residences achieved short-term savings.

Member Events and Activities

Regular Member Receptions with complimentary wine, cheese and musical entertainment will continue through winter, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and from 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday. Fall Projects

Fall projects include some ongoing maintenance and repair work on both Lodges, such as painting the exterior trim to protect it from harsh weather and repairing cement decks. Property wide, roofs and the snowmelt system were updated where necessary, marble in Residences and public areas was polished and elevators were repaired. Refurbishment of Residences was finalized with the installation of new artwork in bedrooms and living rooms.

Contractors extended the life of plumbing in Elkhorn Lodge spa by inserting protective sleeves where possible, and replacing crumbling pipes, as necessary. Elkhorn Lodge pool deck was scheduled for completion of the resurfacing process, but bad weather forced work to be postponed until spring 2020. Also in spring 2020, a new chiller is due for White River Lodge.



Club Operations

Willow Creek Bistro opened November 22 for lunch service. Standard days of operation are from Wednesday to Sunday. Standard hours of operation are from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on all days except Friday and Saturday. Friday and Saturday hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Willow Creek Bistro opens seven days a week for three consecutive weeks from Monday, December 16 to Tuesday, December 31, 2019, with hours as above. The regular schedule resumes on Wednesday, January 1, 2020.

Please ask your Concierge for a schedule of times and designated stops.


















Transportation

Direct shuttles from Aspen Highlands to Snowmass Available Mondays and Tuesdays From December 16, 2019 to April 7, 2020 Depart 8:15 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. Return shuttles from Snowmass to Aspen Highlands Depart 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.

A new direct bus service from Aspen Highlands to Brush Creek Park and Ride (opposite SH 82 entrance to Snowmass Village) is anticipated during the weekends from December 20, 2019.
